# **Position Description | Senior Cabin Leader**

### **Position Purpose**

To be the primary caregivers for campers while on-site. Aiding campers in their mental, spiritual and physical growth as well as basic living needs. Lead a group of campers throughout the daily camp program, facilitating positive group dynamics, enjoyment and adventure, empowerment of each camper, and spiritual engagement.

### **Essential Job Functions:**

- 1. Assist in the direction, supervision and organization of campers in their cabin group during events and activities as well as the time between program elements.**
  - a. Assure campers are properly supervised at all times.
  - b. Be aware of and implement camp safety rules.
  - c. Respect, empower, encourage and support campers.
  4. Help campers to become integrated into all aspects of camp life and program including morning routines, cabin clean-up, meal times, program events and activities.
- 2. Participate in the development and implementation of programs for campers.**
  - a. Responsible for leading and assisting with the leading of activities and events
  - b. Assist in program areas such as but not limited to waterfront, crafts, zipline, archery, etc.
- 3. Maintain high standards of health and safety in ALL activities for campers and staff.**
  - a. Provide the daily care of each camper within your supervision including recognition of personal health needs.
  - b. Be alert to campers and staff needs and assist them with personal or health problems, and discuss or inform the appropriate staff personnel.
  - c. Be alert to equipment and facilities to ensure utilization, proper care and maintenance is maintained; report repairs needed directly to the camp director.
- 4. Be a role model to campers and staff in you attitude and behaviour.**
  - a. Follow and uphold all safety and security rules and procedures.
  - b. Set a good example to campers and others in regard to general camp procedures and practices including sanitation, schedule and sportsmanship.
- 5. Other Responsibilities:**
  - a. Cooperate, communicate and work with co-cabin leader
  - b. Mentor, equip and train the cabin team including Junior Cabin Leaders and LIT Cabin Leaders
  - c. Help campers to improve and develop physically, socially, mentally and spiritually
  - d. Plan daily cabin devotionals with cabin team
  - e. Care for campers through prayer, Bible studies, responsible relationships and sharing of faith in accordance to Bayside Camp's Statement of Faith



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- f. Help campers who have made a commitment to Jesus to apply their faith in their daily lives. Report camper commitments to Directors.
  - g. Communicate with campers, provide instruction and ensure they understand
  - h. Be flexible with the schedule especially on rainy days
  - i. Carry out all other duties assigned by directors
